Every procurement begins with an agency establishing a clear understanding of the need that requires addressing, the views of stakeholders, and the associated risks and opportunities. The process continues through procurement planning, sourcing, contract execution and contract management.

The procurement business case

Suppliers can view procurements that agencies are considering in the following 2 year (goods and services) or 3 year (construction projects) periods on the Forward Procurement Plan.

For example: 'we need to transport an average of 20 children to and from school 5 days a week' not 'we need a bus with 20 seats'.
